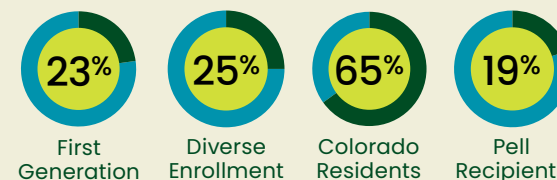

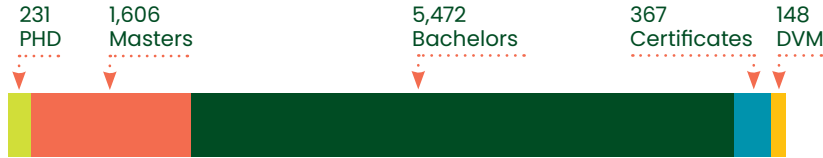

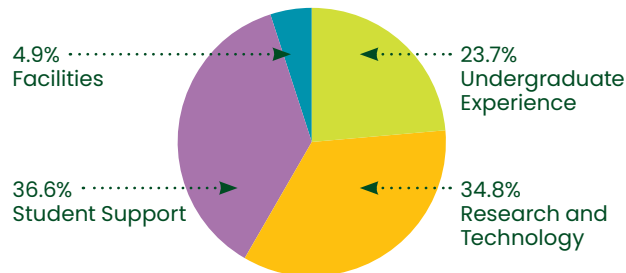

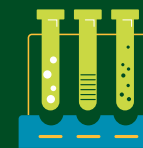
### PERCENTAGE OF PHILANTHROPIC SUPPORT
